Antídoto is located in the province of Soria, in perhaps the coolest microclimate of the Ribera del Duero. The resulting wines are considerably fresher and more elegant than is typical from the appellation.

VINEYARD INFORMATION

Soils: Sand with gravel (50%), sand/limestone 20% and clay 30%

Vines: 100% Tinto Fino from over 300 small parcels throughout the Soria portion of Ribera del Duero. Most parcels are over 100 years old, and many contain ungrafted vines.

Elevation: ~950 m average

Appellation: Ribera del Duero

Harvest: by hand.
