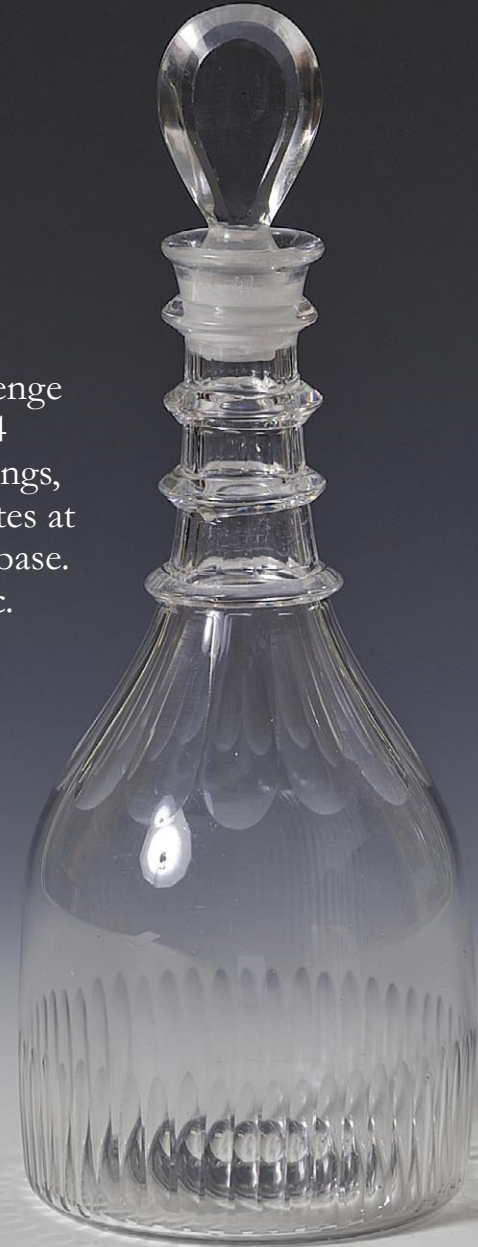

The Georgian Period of the late 18th century represented the height of refined elegance in British and Irish craftsmanship. Normally, we're lucky to acquire 8 to 10 18th-century decanters for our annual offer. This year is a feast of riches, with an unprecedented 17 decanters made between 1770 and 1800. Each of them has survived over 200 years, their uncompromising beauty and delicacy belying their incredible durability.

19th Century

Decanters became more diverse in design, and frequently more fanciful, in the 19th century, particularly in the later Victorian period. But they never lost their grace. Twenty-three decanters in this offer were made between 1810 and 1900.

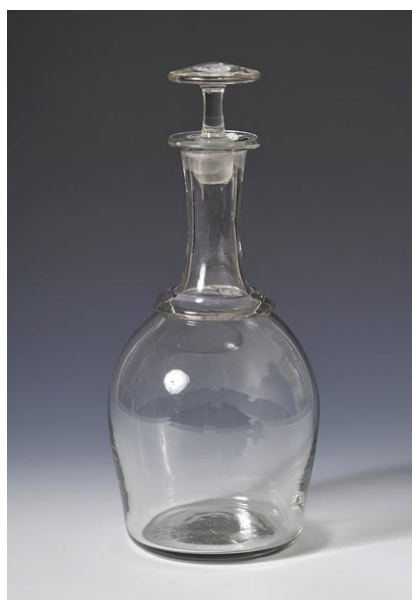

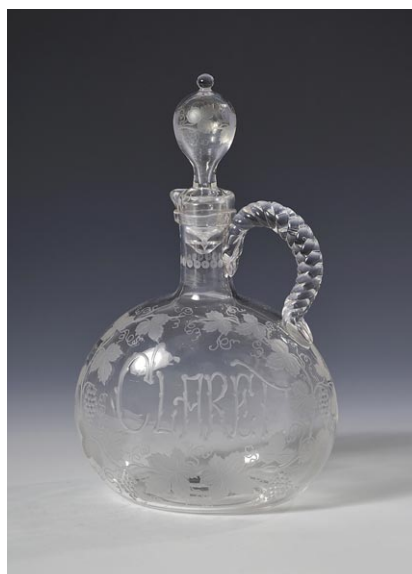

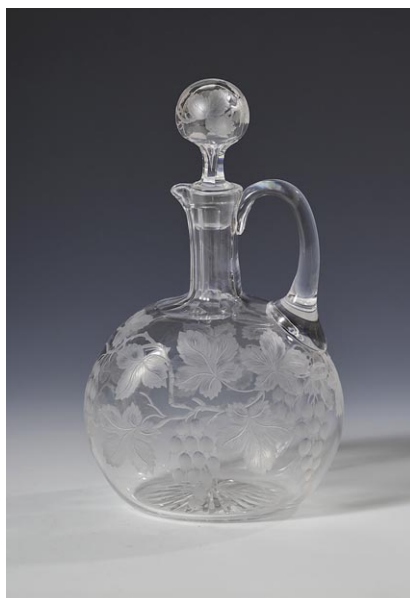
